TITLE VI NOTICE

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000d et seq., is a federal law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in any federally funded program or activity. The U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), has interpreted Title VI's protection from discrimination on the basis of national origin to extend to students who experience discrimination, including harassment, based on their actual or perceived shared ancestry or ethnic characteristics.

“No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”
